Rules and Regulations

- 1. The Junior Fishing Rodeo will be held on Saturday, June 11, 2022; from 9:00 until 11:30. The Junior Fishing Rodeo is strictly for children 5 to 15 years old. Children 5 to 10 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
- 2. The rodeo will be held in the small lake at the south end of Lake Bennington Park, which is along the walking path at Martha's Point.
- 3. There will be NO Fishing in the Small Lake, by residents, guests or anyone else, from May 27, 2022 to June 10, 2022.
- 4. Registration for the Junior Fishing Rodeo will begin at 8:30. in the area, that was formerly the basketball court. The fishing rodeo will be from 9:00am until 11:30am.
- 5. Participants must provide their own bait and tackle for the event.
- 6. No more than 2 poles, rods, or reels per participant, will be allowed.
- 7. Parents are only allowed to help bait and remove the fish from the hook.
- 8. Several drawing will be held for each age category, 5 to 10 and 11 to 15 years. Drawing will be held at the end of the rodeo. **You must be present to win.**
